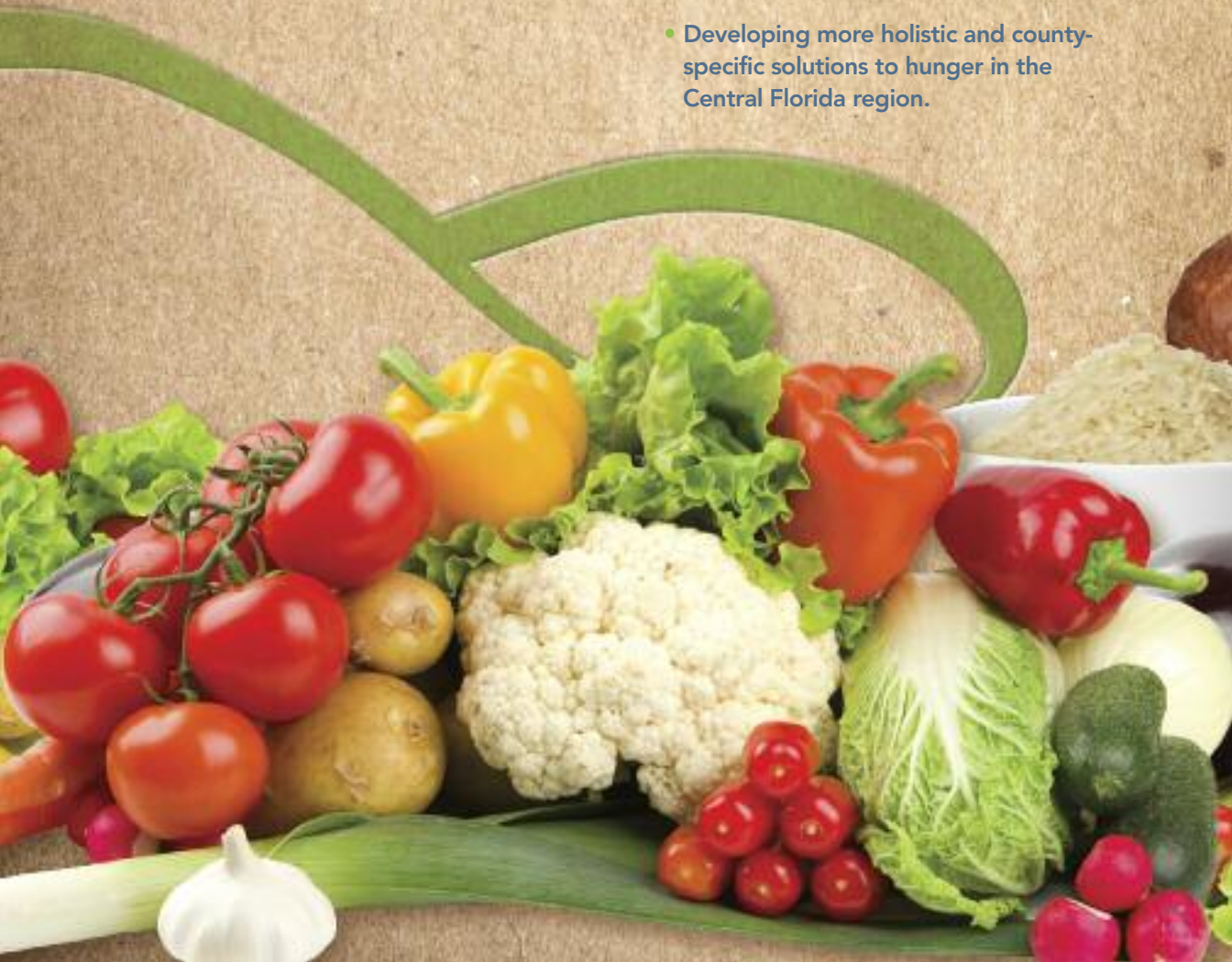

As the economy struggles to recover, the “business” of providing emergency food booms. At Second Harvest, we’ve managed to ramp up our efforts, feeding more people than ever before in our 25-year history. In the past year, our distribution averaged enough food for 30,000 meals per day.

Our Branches

- Since 1997, the Volusia Branch of the Second Harvest Food Bank has been providing food to more than 108 non-profit organizations serving people in need.

In fiscal year 2008/2009, the Volusia Branch provided 2,398,810 pounds of food.

- Founded in 2000, the Brevard Branch distributed 2,052,980 pounds of food to more than 77 non-profit organizations during fiscal year 2008/2009.

Collectively in fiscal 2008/2009, our organization distributed 21,367,913 pounds of food.

Volunteers

In fiscal year 2008/2009, **7,930** volunteers contributed **31,079** hours — the equivalent of more than **15 full-time staff members!** Without this incredible human resource, Second Harvest Food Bank could not begin to have the impact on hunger that our community needs.

food distribution:

More than **331,000** Central Floridians are living in poverty and need food assistance.

General Food Distribution

Products donated by manufacturers, wholesalers, retailers, growers and others are distributed to emergency food pantries, shelters, and other types of agencies serving needy clients. This program distributed 13,678,978 pounds of nutritious food in fiscal 2008/2009. In addition, 343,953 pounds of food were provided for disaster relief efforts.

Kids Cafe

At 13 meal sites, 144,994 meals were distributed in fiscal 2008/2009. More than 490 children are served meals daily.

Community Food Drives

An amazing 1,033,675 pounds of non-perishable grocery products were collected in fiscal 2008/2009 through our Community Food Drives:

TEFAP Distribution

The Florida Department of Agriculture awarded distribution contracts for Orange, Seminole, Lake, Brevard, Volusia and Marion counties to the Second Harvest Food Bank of Central Florida for its distribution program of government food commodities. In fiscal year 2008/2009, a total of 5,043,745 pounds of these wholesome products were made available to Central Floridians in need.

Second Helpings

This prepared and perishable food program collected and distributed 1,144,978 pounds of food in fiscal 2008/2009 to agencies that provide onsite meals for senior citizens, shelters, soup kitchens and non-profit kids programs.

ADEPT

Since the inception of the Agency Development, Education and Partnership Training (ADEPT) program in 2006, over 1,300 staff and volunteers from our six-county span of partner agencies have attended more than 100 classes. In its efforts to empower partner agencies through education, ADEPT offers a variety of trainings including safe food-handling, volunteer management, fundraising, grant writing and strategic planning, as well as many others.

ADEPT is committed to providing educational tools and resources needed to increase agency effectiveness and enhance sustainability. It's our goal to promote the growth and development of our partner agencies so that they may be better prepared to serve the Central Florida community.



benefits connection:

Benefits Connection launched in July 2008 and is designed to help capture a portion of the millions of unclaimed federal dollars for food stamps in Central Florida. These dollars are not claimed due to several reasons: eligible citizens may not have transportation to get to locations where they can apply, lack of awareness of the benefits, disability, language issues, lack of understanding, too few application offices, stigma, etc. The *Benefits Connection* program is designed to overcome these challenges.



Benefits Connection is a team of nine that includes seven mobile outreach benefit specialists that assist people at a variety of convenient locations and provide user-friendly advice and electronic, online benefits application assistance.

Benefits Connection secured over **\$6,000,000** in food stamp benefits for Central Floridians.

In *Benefits Connection's* first year of operations, the team secured over \$6 million in food stamp benefits for Central Floridians.

In addition to food stamp benefits, our specialists are also able to sign clients up for Medicaid, Cash Assistance, KidCare and other programs.

Our second year of *Benefits Connection* is proving to be just as groundbreaking as the first. A Federal Demonstration Project (one of two in the United States) was granted, which allows our specialists to perform the final interview for applicants. This relieves the pressure DCF faces in returning calls. In addition, this has resulted in a much higher approval rate for our cases.

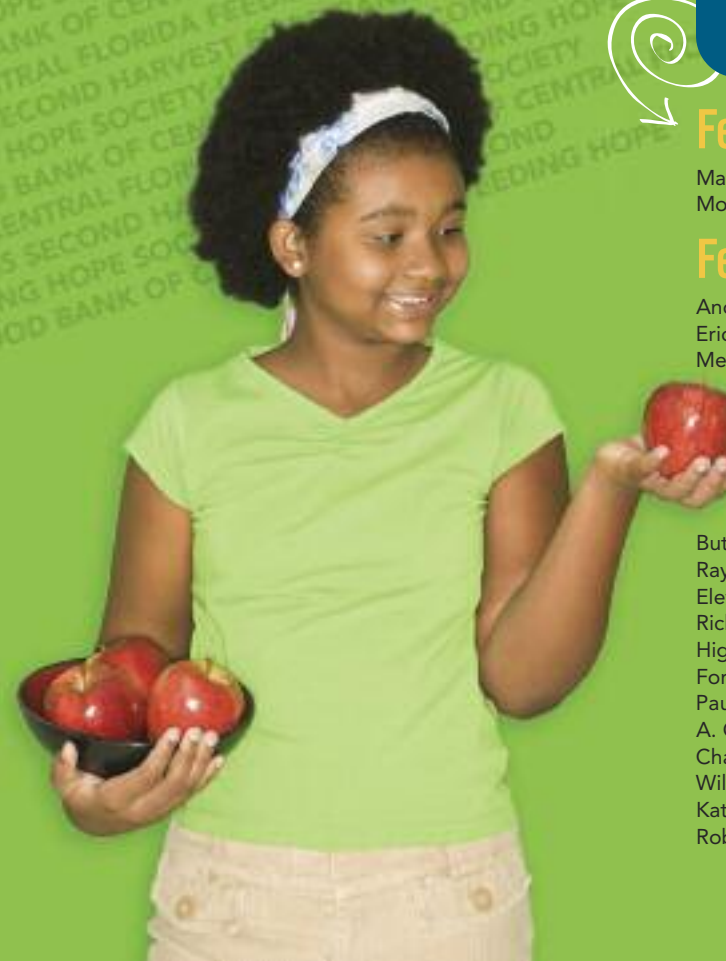
