vans that have onboard refrigeration, electrical outlets, and enough space to safely transport approximately 300 meals per trailer per day per route. Each trailer will make approximately 6-8 stops. Deliveries will be to locations that participate in the summer food service program for children. Drivers will report to our production facility by 6 am and be responsible for loading vehicles. Drivers will be responsible for documenting delivery and for placing meals into refrigerators or shelves inside each location. Drivers will also be responsible for recording temperatures on each delivery slip upon delivery and to check temperatures before leaving our facility. Drivers must attend an orientation at our facility to familiarize with the rules and regulations governing the summer food service program.
